Family Discounts

Sibling discounts apply where a family has two or more children attending the College concurrently:

- 5% on consolidated fees for the second sibling
- 15% on consolidated fees for the third sibling
- 50% on consolidated fees for the fourth (and subsequent) sibling attending concurrently.

The greatest discount applies to the fees for the lowest year level. Sibling discounts do not apply to any additional charges as outlined below. Family discounts do not apply to any student on an international student visa (i.e. International Tuition Fees).

Additional Charges

Items not included in the Tuition fee:

- Year 6 Canberra trip estimated at between \$2,000 - \$3,000
- Year 9 CUE Big Experience trip estimated at \$5,500 - \$7,500, depending on the destination and activities scheduled

- International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme students in Year 11 and Year 12 must pay an annual fee to cover subscription and examination charges. The 2024 fee is \$1,050
- Stationery packs, apps and other class incidentals will vary by year level and range from \$80 - \$200
- Musical instrument hire for curriculum lessons, \$225 per year, inclusive of \$25 insurance fee per annum
- Musical instrument hire for private music lessons, \$200 per semester, inclusive of insurance fee
- Year 4 and 5 students are to supply/purchase sleeping bag and mat for OED Camps
- Year 7 students are required to purchase/hire the following equipment: a hiking pack, waterproof jacket, waterproof pants, sleeping mat and a sleeping bag

Building Fund Donation

A voluntary tax-deductible building fund donation levy can be added to each quarterly account (\$460 per student per annum) and is used to constantly upgrade facilities for students.

Payment of Accounts

Fees are charged on a term basis, with one-quarter of consolidated fees on each account. The exceptions to this are for Year 12 where one-third of annual fees are charged in each of terms 1, 2 and 3 only. Fees are levied one term and 30 days in advance. Notice of withdrawal from the College is required one full school term in advance of withdrawal or fees in lieu of notice will be payable.

International visa student accounts are issued twice per year and payments are required six months in advance.

Student Travel Insurance

The College's travel insurance covers students undertaking College approved trips for declared excursions, hikes, holiday camps, snowsports trips and other intrastate, interstate and international trips with a minimum travel distance of 50km from 163 South Road, Brighton East.

Where the College holds accident insurance for accidental injury or illness of students (who are injured or become ill as a result of their involvement in normal activities associated with their enrolment at the College), parents may make a claim on that insurance policy on the terms set out in the Accident Insurance Cover Claim Form.

The College makes no representation or warranty as to its liability to parents or students for any direct or indirect loss, cost or expense suffered or incurred by a student arising from an accident or personal injury, howsoever caused, or that any cover held by the College will cover such loss, cost or expense.

The College does not take any responsibility for, nor does its insurance cover, privately owned items or College assets or equipment loaned to students. Where damage is more than normal wear or tear, the student/family will be liable for costs associated with repair or replacement. If assets or equipment are accidentally damaged or stolen at home, the College will request that the item be repaired or replaced at the cost of the student's family.

Musical Instrument Hire

Some musical instruments are available to hire for a fee. Students should acquire their own instruments as soon as possible after one year of learning. Piano and keyboard students must have access to their own instruments.

Parents are responsible for the first \$500 towards any repair cost in the event of damage to a hired instrument. In the event that an instrument is unrepairable, lost or stolen, the cost of a replacement instrument will be billed to your fee account.

It is recommended that you check your personal home insurance policy covers the instrument you have hired as part of your standard policy, as the College will not cover loss due to theft, home fire or malicious damage.

Instrument hire costs for curriculum lessons is \$225 per year and instrument hire costs for private music lessons is \$200 per semester. Books and accessories will be charged to school accounts where required.

Cancellation Policy

Once enrolled in private lessons, a student is expected to attend for the entire school year. If there is a genuine reason to withdraw part way through the year, cancellation is required in writing to the teacher on or before the dates listed in the table. Verbal cancellation will not be accepted.

Refunds will not be issued for missed lessons. Special consideration may be given if a student is absent for four consecutive weeks and a medical certificate is supplied.*
